Range Rules Review – Cease Fire Procedure

Anyone may call a Cease Fire at any time.

When a Cease Fire is called, every shooter must immediately:

1. Stop shooting
2. Remove all ammunition from his firearm
3. Place his firearm on the table, pointed downrange with its action locked or propped open, and
4. Step back from his table.

Once everyone has stepped back, the RO must inspect each firearm to verify that it is unloaded.

As long as the Cease Fire remains in effect, everyone must stay away from the shooting tables.

The Cease Fire will remain in effect until a Commence Fire command is issued.

After ensuring that both doors are closed, that the fans are on and that everyone is behind the firing line and wearing eye and ear protection, the RO may issue a "Commence Fire" command.

Two Best Bass Team Tournament Rules

- Sign in time will be 1 hour before start time.
- Boats will be released in the order in which they sign in.
- Late comers must find tournament director to sign in before fishing.
- Max 3 people per boat, each must have a valid CA fishing license if over the age of 15.
- There must be at least one active member per boat.
- Guests are limited to 3 visits on the property. Children over 21 are limited to 3 visits per year.
- Live wells are mandatory.
- Dead fish will not be weighed.
- There will be a 10mph speed limit for the first ½ hour, and 30mph after that.
- Pre-fishing one day before the tournament is not allowed.
- Artificial baits only.
- 12" minimum length, measured on WIL-E-GO flat board.
- Please have required Coast Guard safety equipment on board.
