### Low-To-The-Left Pistol Shoot

### Range Rules Review

Putty had to be deployed because one of our shooters forgot two important rules:

1. Targets must always be placed as close as possible to the rubber backstop. This shooter, wanting to shorten the range (a good thing) moved the retrievable target toward his bench (a bad thing) rather than move his bench toward the target.
2. If you are not an excellent marksman or you are shooting a gun with which you are not thoroughly familiar, start with your bench at the yellow limit line. This shooter was introducing his daughter to pistol shooting (a good thing) but set her up at the fifty-foot mark (a bad thing).

*Otra cosita mas:* only BRASS cases should be left in the brass bucket. The brass we collect in that bucket will very nearly pay for our next backstop cleaning. But the recyclers only want brass. Please put your steel and aluminum cases in the trash.

### California Gun Law Drama

After a false start, California Department of Justice finally

published new "Bullet Button" regulations on May 18th. You can most easily find the new regulations by going to a site maintained by the Firearms Policy Coalition:

Now that regulations have been published, any rifle which has naughty features and a "detachable magazine" as newly defined, must either be registered as an assault weapon by January 1st or modified to comply with the new regulations.
