Targets - B 2, B 3 and A 17 – can be found in a tray by the white board. But if you should find that tray empty, you'll find stacks of targets on that shelf that is to your right as you enter the ready room.

The Lead Off will also be available by the white board. It's marvelous stuff. A single towelette will do a better job of decontaminating your hands than would washing them with soap and water.

Air Gun Rule

Because it seems that someone forgot it, let's review the air gun rule before someone loses a tooth.

Pellet guns are permitted in our range. However, BB guns are prohibited in our range because BB's will bounce back from the backstop.

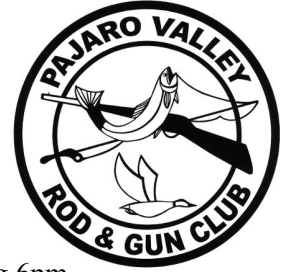
Range Orientations
