Colt Python

The Python is the Cadillac of the Colt double-action line. It has been manufactured since 1955 and is still the flagship of the line. It is chambered for the .357 Magnum cartridge, holds 6 shots, and has been offered in barrel lengths of 2.5", 3", 4", 6", and 8". This revolver is offered finished in high polished Colt Royal Blue, nickel-plate, matte-finish stainless steel, or what is known as "The Ultimate"—a high polished stainless steel. The 3" barrel, as well as the nickel plating, has been discontinued. The grips are checkered walnut. It is possible that the nickel-plated specimens may bring a 10 percent premium. In my experience this is not always the case as many potential purchasers have a definite preference for the blued finish. Reintroduced into the Colt product line in 2001 as the Python Elite. Early (pre-1966) models command 10 percent to 25 percent premium in Exc. or better condition. Discontinued 2005.
