## Glock Wins Appeal In Lawsuit

In San Francisco, "The 9th Circuit upheld a federal law shielding gun-makers and dealers from lawsuits filed by victims of gun crimes," according to Courthouse News Service. "The court dismissed a challenge brought by victims of a 1999 shooting at a Jewish community center summer camp in Granada Hills, Calif.... The victims of the shooting and the postal worker's wife sued Glock, RSR Wholesale Guns Seattle and other members of the gun industry in 2001, claiming they intentionally flooded the market with guns, increasing the risk that the weapons would fall into the wrong hands." But in 2005, Congress passed the "Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act," specifically to shield gunmakers and sellers from liability stemming from the criminal use of their products. "The district court determined that the federal law pre-empted the plaintiffs' state-law claims. The San Francisco-based federal appeals court agreed that federal law, and not state law, governed the case."

Commented Alan Gottlieb, founder of the Second Amendment Foundation, "We are delighted that the Ninth Circuit panel not only affirmed the lower court ruling, but also that the court upheld the constitutionality of the federal law prohibiting this kind of lawsuit. While we sympathize with the victims, it would be an egregious miscarriage of justice to hold gun manufacturers responsible for the acts of criminals over whom they have no control."
