Are you an OATHKEEPER ?

I have to wonder how many of you reading this are military or law enforcement. If you are, like me you took an oath to "uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States, against all enemies; foreign, and domestic."

So with that in mind, left's take a look-at "laws" we members of Oathkeepers will not enforce.

1. We WILL NOT obey any order to disarm the American people. The purpose of the Second Amendment has nothing to do with deer hunting or any other kind of "sporting purpose." The Second Amendment's purpose is to preserve military power-in the hands of the people so that as a last resort they have recourse to armed resistance to acts of tyranny.
2. We WILL NOT obey any order to conduct warrantless searches of the American people, their homes, vehicles, papers or effects.
3. We WILL NOT obey any order to detain American citizens as "unlawful enemy combatants" or to subject them to military tribunal.
4. We WILL NOT obey orders to impose martial law or a "state of emergency" on a state, or to enter with force into a state, without the express consent and invitation of that state's legislature & governor.
5. We WILL NOT obey orders to invade and subjugate any state that asserts its authority and declares the national government to be in violation of the compact by which that state entered the union., At the time of this writing, some 25 states either have passed or have in process "nullification resolutions" that essentially state that if the federal government continues to violate the Constitution, the compact established between the state and the national government is nullified and the state will secede.
6. We WILL NOT obey any order to blockade American cities, thus turning them into giant concentration camps. The blockade of Boston was another underlying cause of the American Revolution. Similar tactics were used by the Nazis against the Warsaw Ghetto and by the Japanese against Nanking, turning the cities into death camps. Any such order is an act of treason and will be treated accordingly.
7. We WILL NOT obey any order to force American citizens into any form of detention camps und& any pretext.'''
When a government interns its own people, it is treating them like an occupied enemy population.
8. We WILL NOT obey orders to assist or support the use of foreign troops on U.S. soil against the American People to "keep the peace" or to "maintain control" during any emergency or under any other pretext. We will consider such use of foreign troops against our people to be an invasion and act of war.
9. We WILL NOT obey any orders to confiscate the property of the American people, including food and other essential supplies, under any emergency pretext whatsoever. Food deprivation and depriving essential supplies and services has long been used to oppress millions of people.
10. We WILL NOT obey any orders which infringe on the rights of free speech, peaceful assembly and to petition their government for a redress Of grievances.

The American Revolution would not have happened without fiery writers and speakers like Thomas Paine, Patrick Henry and Sam Adams. Without freedom of speech, there is no freedom. Thus Oathkeepers will not obey or support orders that violate or suppress the rights of the people to associate, worship, communicate or petition government for redress of grievances. So there you have it - 10 orders we will not obey. They aren't all inclusive, but constitute "tripwires" that will tell us that perhaps the time has come for another American Revolution. If you are in Military or law enforcement and haven't considered the meaning of the oath you took and the direction that our country is headed at the moment, you should do so. .I'm not calling for rebellion, **but the time may come when it is necessary to preserve our Constitutional Republic.**
