Definition of Shotgun

I am not a lawyer, but I have concerns your answer to David Yocum's question on minimum barrel length may cause him trouble. Your answer is only partly correct. The Federal law on minimum barrel length is: Shotguns — minimum of 18-inch barrel. and ..a minimum overall length of Rifles — minimum inches with a-: of 26 inches.

If you take a shotgun and put a pistol grip on it and cut the barrels to 10 inches so it can be shot one-handed, you have a sawed off shotgun, very illegal.

Thompson Center got into trouble a few years ago for making their TC Contender able to shoot .410 shot shells.

If you have a T. C. or similar hand gun it better have rifling and be made as a pistol that is long chambered to take .45 Colt and can also take .410 shot shells or it is chambered for 45-70 and you can chamber a .410 shot shell in it., The Judge is long chambered for 45 Colt, so long that a .410 shot shell will fit.

I live in the Socialistick State of Kaliphornia we can not have the Judge or any other pistol that long chambered to take both .45 Colt and a .410 shot shell as they are listed as sawed off/short shotguns, the same as the T.C. that shoots .410 shot shells. I can load my revolver in A5 Colt/.357 mag./ .44 mag. with a shot cartridge, i.e. a plastic shot capsule, in place of the projectile, and carry it if I have it on my CCW permit.:

Now Mossberg makes a shotgun (Just in Case 12 ga. M500) that has a pistol grip only (no shoulder stock), an 18-inch barrel with an overall length of 26 inches, which is legal in the Socialistick State of, Kaliphornia.

Now can you see the difference between a sawed off shot gun and a shot pistol ?

More Definition of Shotgun

Your response to David Yocum on incomplete, alas. The Taurus "Judge" passes regulatory muster because it is a handgun that can fire a .410 shotshell, and not a shotgun. The distinction comes in with the presence or absence of rifling. If a handgun is used to fire a shotgun shell, it must have a rifled barrel. If the barrel is smooth bore, the firearm is considered a "short-barreled shotgun" and classified as an AOW, even though it looks and functions like a handgun. The "shoulder" criterion does not apply when it comes to shotguns, though it does with rifled arms.

Thompson-Center Arms ran afoul of this regulation with the then-ATF many years ago, when they introduced their .45 Colt/.410 barrel for their Contender pistol. T-C attempted to conform to the regulation by rifling the barrel with a twist of 1-in-infinity, that is, with rifling that did not spiral at all, but just ran straight from the breech to the muzzle. The ATF shut that down. I seem to recall that the regulation was met in at least one case (perhaps even this one) with a barrel whose rifling began just a few inches before the muzzle. While rifling is necessary for bullets to perform at their best, rifling
