I started to write an article about all the antigun legislation pending in Sacramento, but I soon realized that a complete list would fill this newsletter. So here are a few of the worst bills that will land on the Governor's desk: all firearms in your home must be locked away, even if you are present; all rifles with detachable magazines banned; state-wide ban on hunting with lead ammunition; 2 years after two manufacturers offer handguns with biometric locks, no other type of handgun can be added to the "safe" roster (this law, like existing law requiring micro-stamping, is aimed at outlawing virtually all modern

pistols in this State), and last but not least, all magazines that hold more than 10 rounds are outlawed (the magazines you already own are not grandfathered).

Silence implies consent! Make that call. Governor Jerry Brown (916) 445-2841
