Two Security Models

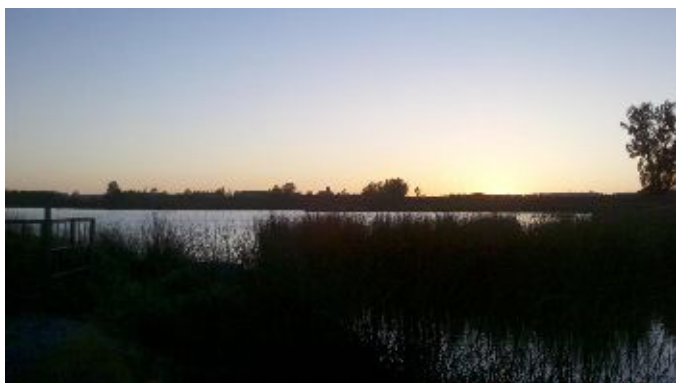
