## Bass Derby News

### Two Best Bass Team Tournament Rules

- Sign in time will be ½ hour before start time.
- Entry fee \$20 per boat, and \$5 big fish option per person.
- Max 3 people per boat, each must have a valid CA fishing license if over the age of 15.
- There must be one active member per boat.
- Live wells are mandatory and will be checked at sign-in.
- Late comers must find tournament director to sign-in before fishing.
- The order in which you sign-in will determine the order in which you will be released.
- There will be a 10mph speed limit for the first ½ hour, and 25mph after that.
- Pre-fishing one day before the tournament is not allowed.
- Artificial baits only.
- 12" minimum length, measured on a WIL-E-GO flat board.
- Dead fish will not be weighed.
- Please have required Coast Guard safety equipment on board.

## Free and Reduced-Fee Sport Fishing Licenses

California Dept of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) offers reduced-fee sport fishing licenses to honorably-discharged veterans with a service-connected disability rating of at least 50 percent and to resident low-income seniors who are at least 65 years of age.

Free sport fishing licenses are available to eligible persons who are blind; low-income American Indians; developmentally disabled persons; and residents who are so severely physically disabled that they are permanently unable to move from place to place without the use of a wheelchair, walker, forearm crutches, or a comparable mobility-related device.

### Recovering Service Member Reduced fee Sport Fishing License

Any recovering service member of the US military is eligible for a reduced-fee sport fishing license. The term "recovering service member" means a member of the Armed Forces, including a member of the National Guard or a Reserve, who is undergoing medical treatment, recuperation, or therapy and is in an outpatient status while recovering from a serious injury or illness related to the member's military service.

Anglers must obtain their first free or reduced fee sport fishing license from a CDFW license sales office, where their eligibility requirements will be verified.
