Harry Williams and Robbie Brooks have been working on improving our launch ramp and dock. If you would like to help, contact Robbie.

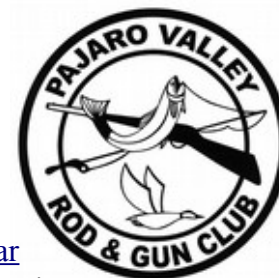
