Semiauto Clinic and Semiauto First Aid Station

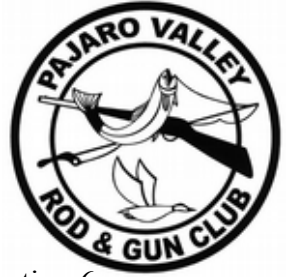

Supreme Court decided that the 2nd Amendment applies to the several States], the City was forced to pay NRA more than \$600,000 in attorney's fees. Now that it's lost *Benson v. City of Chicago* [in which the District Court overturned the City's ban on both open and concealed carry, its ban on gun stores, its ban on firing ranges, its ban on self-defense in garages, porches, and yards; and its ban on keeping more than one gun in an operable state] the City has been ordered to pay NRA \$940,000 more.

Who may use the Range:

The following individuals, and only the following individuals, may use the range:

Members of the Shooters Association

1. Spouses of members of the Shooters Association only while accompanied and supervised by the qualifying Shooters Association member.
2. Children, under 21 years of age, of members of the Shooters Association only while accompanied and supervised by the qualifying Shooters Association member.
3. Guests of members of the Shooters Association only while accompanied and supervised by the qualifying Shooters Association member. Guest use of the range is subject to the same limitations upon the number of such uses as is guest use of other Pajaro Valley Rod & Gun Club facilities.
