Kelly Lake Status

The lake is nearly dry between the ramp and the main part of the lake. It is no longer possible to take boats out without carrying them through the muck. Be careful to avoid getting stuck.

Transfer of Firearms between Family Members

(excerpted from "California Firearms Laws Summary 2103", Office of the Attorney General, California Dept. of Justice)

The infrequent transfer of firearms between immediate family members is exempt from the law requiring (Person to Person Transfers) to be conducted through a licensed firearms dealer. For purposes of this exemption, "immediate family member" means parent and child, and grandparent and grandchild but does not include brothers or sisters. (Pen. Code, § 16720.) Please note that if the firearm being transferred is a handgun, the transferee must comply with the Handgun Safety Certificate requirement, prior to taking possession of the firearm. Within 30 days of the transfer, the transferee must also submit a report of the transaction to the DOJ. To obtain the required report form (Report of Operation of Law or Intra-Familial Handgun Transaction BOF 4544A), either contact the DOJ Bureau of Firearms at (916) 227-7527 or download the form from the DOJ's website.
