Attention Shotgunners

Please don't turn our chipped rubber backstop into a shotgun wad backstop. Count your shots and when you're done make sure you retrieve at least as many wads. Some of them will be on the floor. Those in the backstop can be easily flicked out with a rake.

Target Retrieval

Would you believe our target retrieval is working again?

You can thank Howard Conner.

Now let's keep it working by following two simple rules.

1) Always keep the target as close to the rubber as physically possible. Never draw the target closer for short range shooting. Move your table up instead.

2) Mount your target low on the backing, as shown on the right.
