A Right to Bear Arms

The 2nd Amendment acknowledges a right to keep and BEAR arms. California is sand-bagging *Peruta* and the District of Columbia is sand-bagging *Wren*, but the writing is on the wall. "Shall issue" will be the rule even in the 20% of States that don't already have it.

And after concealed carry is unremarkable, all the other pointless gun laws fall away one by one as folks look down at their feet and notice there is no "blood on the streets". Ever greater firearm liberty has been the trend in every State that has adopted "shall issue".

By the way, note that *Peruta* and *Wren* are not solely concerned with permits to bear concealed arms. When open carry is outlawed a permit is required to bear arms at all.

In the NRA formulation, the second rule of safe gun handling is "ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot."
