Our first gold medal and the first gold medal of the 2016 Olympics was won by a girl with a gun.

Nineteen-year-old Ginny Thrasher first fired a gun five years ago while she was in eighth grade, hunting deer with her grandfather.



She won the women's 10-meter air rifle event with a

score of 208.0, setting an Olympic record. She also set a record as the youngest woman to win the first gold medal of the Olympics.

"This is very special for me. For me to start out Rio 2016 with a gold medal for the U.S.A. makes me incredibly proud," Thrasher said. "I'm happy to positively represent my country."
