January Pistol Shoot

Aklys Defense CCI Quiet 10/22 Conversion

For \$270, Aklys Defense [(225) 448-3167] will convert your 10/22 to function with CCI Quiet ammunition. The rifle will still function with standard velocity ammunition, though not with high velocity ammunition.

In a New Jersey criminal prosecution, defendant Lambert pled guilty to possession of a stun gun. Stun guns are outlawed in New Jersey. On appeal the New Jersey Attorney General agreed with the defendant's position that the stun gun ban is unconstitutional:

"[T]he State agrees with defendant's reading of United States Supreme Court precedent. To briefly recap Second-Amendment jurisprudence, the United States Supreme Court held that "the Second Amendment extends, prima facie, to all instruments that constitute bearable arms, even those that were not in existence at the time of the founding." *District of Columbia v. Heller*, 554 U.S. 570, 582 (2008), and that this "Second Amendment right is fully applicable to the States[.]" *McDonald v. Chicago*, 561 U.S. 742, 750 (2010)."

Two Best Bass Team Tournament Rules

- Sign in time will be 1 hour before start time.
- Boats will be released in the order in which they sign in.
- Late comers must find tournament director to sign in before fishing.
- Max 3 people per boat, each must have a valid CA fishing license if over the age of 15.
- There must be at least one active member per boat.
- Guests are limited to 3 visits on the property. Children over 21 are limited to 3 visits per year.
- Live wells are mandatory.
- Dead fish will not be weighed.
- There will be a 10mph speed limit for the first ½ hour, and 30mph after that.
- Pre-fishing one day before the tournament is not allowed.
- Artificial baits only.
- 12" minimum length, measured on WIL-E-GO flat board.
- Please have required Coast Guard safety equipment on board.
