President Trump's signal promise to gun owners, national reciprocity, won him the enthusiastic support of NRA-ILA, Gun Owners of America, the National Shooting Sports Foundation, and Second Amendment Foundation. Introduced on the very first day of the new Congress, Representative Hudson's bill would allow anyone with a state-issued concealed carry license or permit to conceal a handgun in any other state that allows concealed carry, as long as the permit holder follows the laws of that state. Time will tell.

### February's Tournament

Unfortunately, February's tournament had to be cancelled due to the major storms. See you on the water in March!

### Two Best Bass Team Tournament Rules

- Sign in time will be 1 hour before start time.
- Boats will be released in the order in which they sign in.
- Late comers must find tournament director to sign in before fishing.
- Max 3 people per boat, each must have a valid CA fishing license if over the age of 15.
- There must be at least one active member per boat.
- Guests are limited to 3 visits on the property. Children over 21 are limited to 3 visits per year.
- Live wells are mandatory.
- Dead fish will not be weighed.
- There will be a 10mph speed limit for the first ½ hour, and 30mph after that.
- Pre-fishing one day before the tournament is not allowed.
- Artificial baits only.
- 12" minimum length, measured on WIL-E-GO flat board.
- Please have required Coast Guard safety equipment on board.
