## Range News

### Concealed Carry Surge

The annual concealed carry survey released July 19th by the Crime Prevention Research Center (founded by John R. Lott Jr.) reported that as of November of last year over 16.3 million citizens had concealed carry permits. That amounts to 6.53% of all adult citizens. Outside the restrictive states like California and New York, that figure rises to about 8%. Of course, permit holders are only a fraction of lawful concealed carriers since fifteen States have adopted constitutional carry.

The survey also reported that concealed handgun permit holders are extremely law abiding. The percent of permit holders charged or convicted of a felony in 2016 was 0.0092%.

### Ruger Mark IV Recall

Ruger Mark IV pistols (including Target, Competition, 22/45, 22/45 Lite and 22/45 Tactical models) produced prior to June 1, 2017, are being recalled to fix a defect that can result in an unintentional discharge upon disengaging the safety.

The affected models bear serial numbers beginning with "401" (2017 models) or "WBR" (2016 models). If you think you may have one of these pistols, contact the Recall Call Center at 1-800-784-3701 or visit the recall webpage

Mark I, Mark II and Mark III pistols are not affected by this recall.

### California Legal News

#### PERUTA

The Supreme Court declined to hear our appeal from the Ninth Circuit's decision in Peruta that the right to bear

arms outside the home may be subject to purely discretionary curtailment. The Circuits remain split and we are unlikely to have a definitive answer until the balance of the Court shifts one way or another. Gorsuch merely replaced Scalia. The next appointment will be critical.

Justice Clarence Thomas: "For those of us who work in marbled halls, guarded constantly by a vigilant and dedicated police force, the guarantees of the Second Amendment might seem antiquated and superfluous. But the Framers made a clear choice: They reserved to all Americans the right to bear arms for self-defense. I do not think we should stand by idly while a State denies its citizens that right, particularly when their very lives may depend on it."

#### DUNCAN

In *Duncan v. Becerra* a District Court has granted NRA and CRPA's request for an injunction against the enforcement of the ban on mere possession of magazines holding more than ten rounds. But this is only an injunction pending trial and may even be withdrawn before trial. The injunction only issued because the judge believes, for now, that the plaintiffs will ultimately prevail and that failure to delay the law pending trial would result in irreparable harm to the plaintiffs.

Honorable Rother T. Benitez: "The state claims the ban is aimed at halting 'gun violence.' Violent gun use is a constitutionally-protected means for law abiding citizens to protect themselves from criminals."

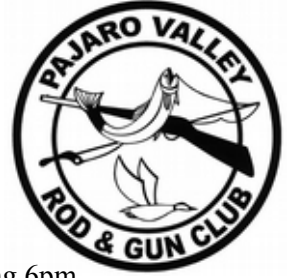
#### SENATE BILL 620
