### Impossibility of Gun Control

Isn't it becoming increasingly obvious that as small-scale computer-aided manufacture gets cheaper, gun control gets harder?

3-D printing is already affordable to the home hobbyist, and soon 3-D printers that work with metals will be as well.

And we are seeing the same trend in CNC metal cutting technology. A very affordable example, though this one is for now limited to finishing 80% receivers, is the "[Ghost Gunner](#)" at right.

It is a \$1600 milling machine that will produce receivers "in the comfort and privacy of your own home".

In short, as technology affordable to the home hobbyist becomes more powerful, banning home firearm manufacture will be no more possible than banning knowledge. In fact, firearms are already the least dangerous weapons capable of being produced in the average garage - but that's the subject for a different article.

### Use of Lake

4. Guests of members of the Shooters Association only while accompanied and supervised by the qualifying Shooters Association member. Guest use of the range is subject to the same limitations upon the number of such uses as is guest use of other Pajaro Valley Rod & Gun Club facilities.
